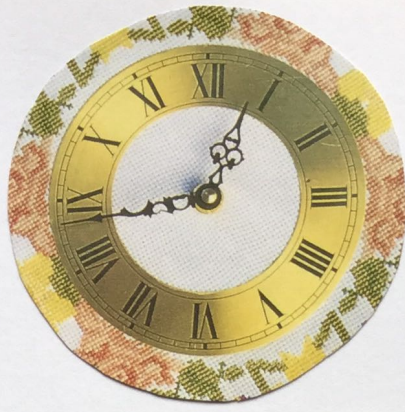
PREFACE TO THE FAMILY HISTORY
